| 16 | the times that we are going through here, but,          |
| 17 | with the Federal assistance, possibly, coming our       |
| 18 | way, we decided to reevaluate the budget.               |
| 19 | And, we are going to be making an amendment             |
| 20 | to the budget.  |
| 21 | So, I am asking this Board to amend 2020/21             |
| 22 | final budget by changing the tax rate table as          |
| 23 | follows:  |
| 24 | Less surplus to be appropriated, two                    |
| 25 | million one hundred thousand to two million nine        |

| 11 | increase from 4.86 to 2.25.  |
| 12 | I need a Motion to move forward with this.                         |
| 13 | DEPUTY MAYOR HAWXHURST: So moved.                                  |
| 14 | TRUSTEE BOCCIO: Second.  |
| 15 | MAYOR BEACH: All in favor?   |
